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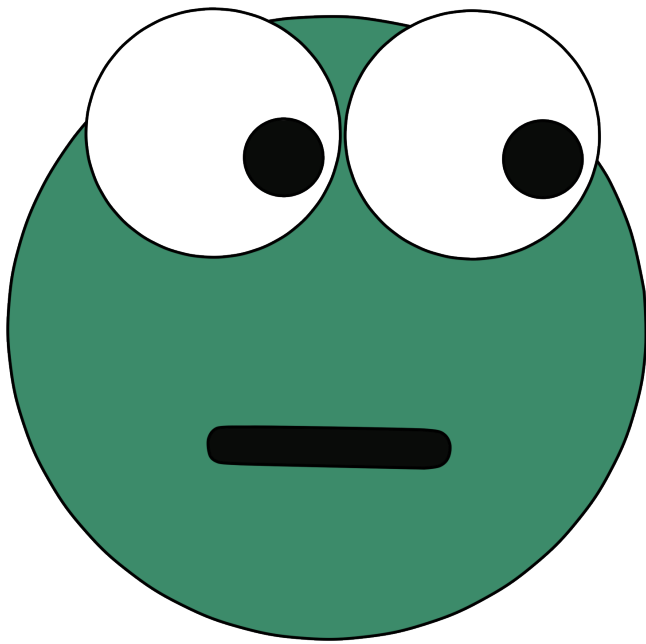
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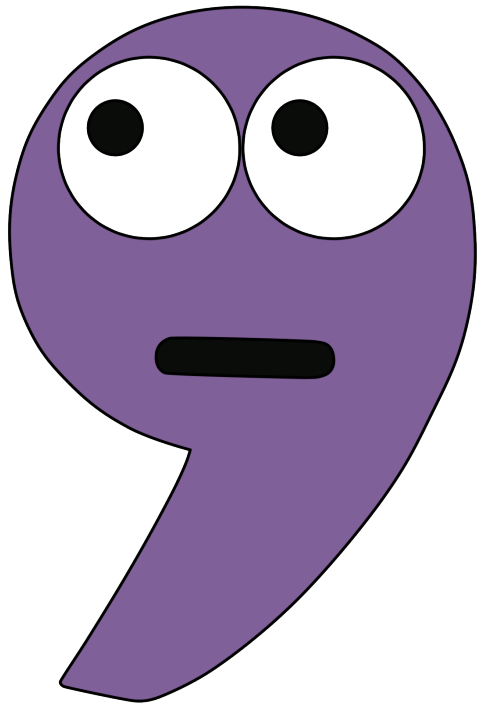


Period

Comma

A comma can be used to list things. It can be used in the middle of a sentence, to make a short pause between thoughts.

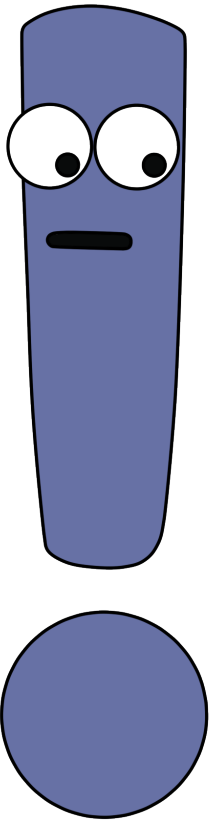


Question Mark

*** Example***

What day is it?

A question mark is used at the end of a sentence that asks something.

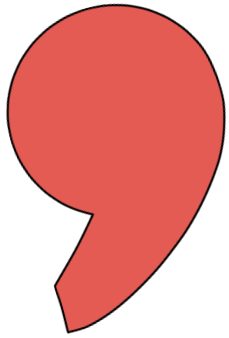


Exclamation Point

*** Example***

An exclamation point at the end of a sentence shows strong feelings like surprise, anger, or fear.

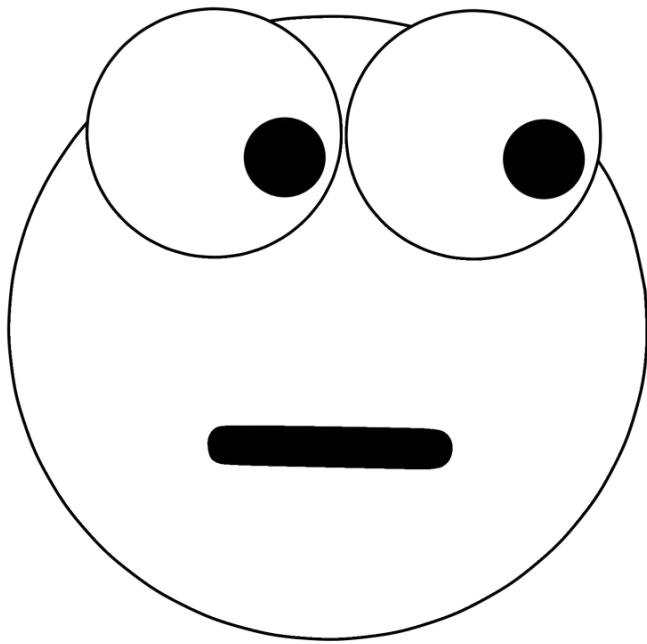


Semicolon

A semicolon is used to join two complete, closely related thoughts. It is placed after the first thought and before the second thought.

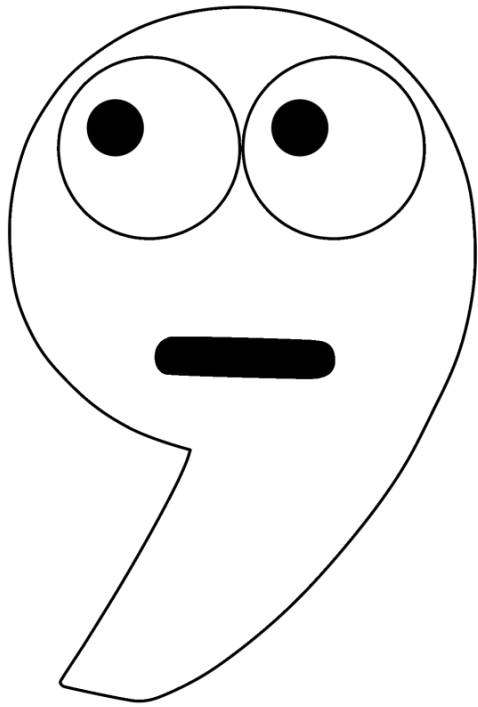


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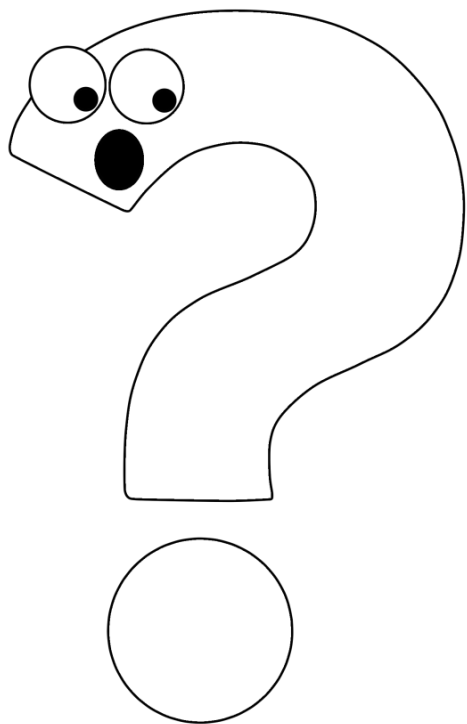


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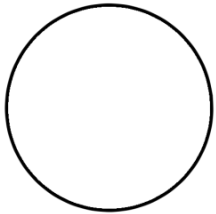
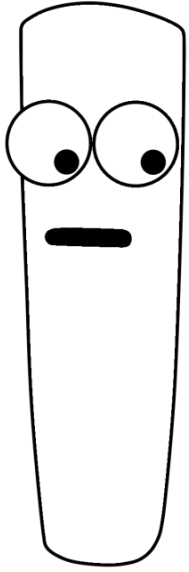


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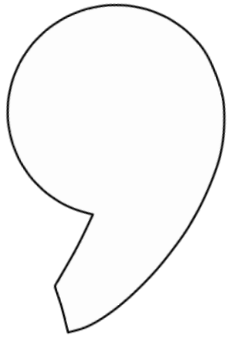
