The FIFA World Cup is a massive sporting competition that is contested by senior men's national teams from the 208 Member Associations of FIFA.

Starting in 1930, this competition is played every four years with the exception of 1942 and 1946 when it was not played due to World War II.



The Beginning of the FIFA World Cup

The first FIFA World Cup was held in Montevideo, Uruguay in July 1930. There were 13 teams involved and 70 goals scored during the Cup. The final contest was between Argentina and Uruguay, with Uruguay winning 4-2.

The organisers of this event were so disappointed that only four European teams had made the effort to participate that, at the next FIFA World Cup four years later, Uruguay became the first and only team to refuse to defend their title.

This world wide competition has been played every four years since, with the exception of 1942 and 1946 when it was not played due to World War II.



FIFA World Cup

So far, there have been 19 FIFA World Cup tournaments which have been won by eight different national teams.

- Brazil has won it five times
- Italy has won it four times
- Germany has won it three times
- Argentina and Uruguay have each won it twice
- England, France and Spain have each won it once


In 2014, this tournament was held in Brazil, with Germany coming out on top. This year, 2018, the tournament is being held in Russia and in 2022, it will be held in Qatar.







Zabivaka's colours represent the Russian flag while his big grin shows how welcoming and friendly he is.
